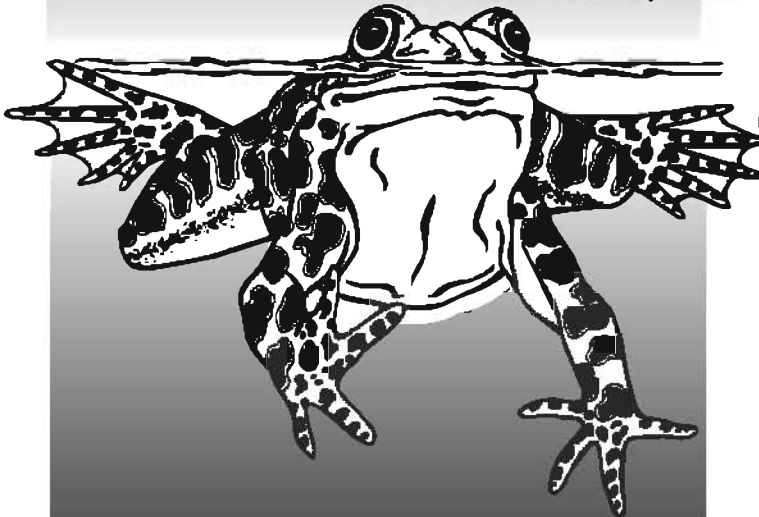

► **Sepulveda Basin Wetland Family Fieldtrip
January 12, 2008**

We will explore the importance of wetlands and why they are vital to our ecological health. In addition, we will learn why animals inhabit this area for days, weeks or year round. With the aid of microscopes & binoculars, we will see the food chain from the bottom to the top. Please bring binoculars (we only have a few to lend), water, lunch & sturdy shoes.

February 9, 2008**

Come and learn the many reasons that cause a species to become threatened or endangered and how we can help. A hike and guest speaker as well as a related craft will be offered.

► **Great Backyard Bird Count
February 16, 2008
8am - 10am**

Every year at this time the public is asked to count the number of species of birds in their own backyard.

At Headwaters Corner we can use some help counting the birds in our backyard! This is an important and fun event.

All you need is binoculars. Important data is sent to scientists at Cornell Ornithology Lab and the Audobon Society to highlight this year's trends & findings. Refreshments will be offered. **Fee free**

► **Birds
March 8, 2008**

In this session we will learn about birds & their behavior. We will examine owl pellets and through microscopes, the structure of feathers. There will be a hike & a related craft. Please bring binoculars if you have them.

**Most sessions include a hike,

and a related craft.**

Through guided discovery, and the aid of scientific tools, participants will learn about natural history, ecological concepts, and environmental concerns.

Activities are prepared with the use of a strong science and environmental focus using hands-on and in-field instructional techniques that provide a positive and enriching learning experience.

This program can also be conducted on weekdays for home-schooled children, as well as weekends for special events such as Birthday Parties and for Scout Troops.
