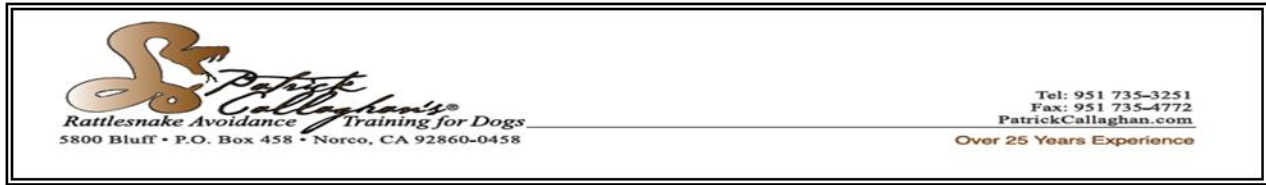

Rattlesnake Avoidance Training for Your Dog By Patrick Callaghan Aug. 29 and Aug. 30 at Tapia Park Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas (see map)

Patrick Callaghan is a well-known professional dog trainer with over 40 years experience. He uses a remote training collar and muzzled rattlesnakes to train your dog to avoid rattlesnakes. The training is conducted in a safe, humane, controlled environment ensuring the safety of your dog, as well as the safety of the rattlesnakes.

In order to learn a strong avoidance behavior, Patrick recommends several repetitions of the training. Your dog must be at least 4 months old. The first year, "Initial training" is when the dog learns intense avoidance of rattlesnakes. The second year, "Maintenance training," is what really cements this Behavior within your dog. To ensure maximum benefit from this training, maintenance training should be done the following year after initial training.
